David Díaz Viñolas is a researcher at the Institute of Marine Sciences (ICM-CSIC) in Barcelona. David was involved in the biologic monitoring of the Medes Islands Protected Area, where he worked on most of his thesis on the ecology of the European spiny lobster. In the last few years, he has specialised in radio-tracking to assess the mobility of lobsters and to understand the role of marine reserves in the conservation of large decapods. Currently he is Scientific Coordinator and Coordinator of the ICM-CSIC Partner for the 2014-2015 ENPI-EU Project entitled ECOSAFIMED - Towards Ecosystem Conservation and Sustainable Artisanal Fisheries in the Mediterranean basin.
